**NOTE 1:**

Building coverage is the percentage of your lot that is covered by buildings including sheds, garages, covered porches, patios, gazebos & other structures with a roof

**NOTE 2:**

Impervious coverage is the percent of your lot that is covered by surfaces that do not absorb rain. Impervious surfaces include all buildings, paving areas, driveways, roads, sidewalks & any areas in concrete and asphalt including porous asphalt paving. The area of a swimming pool located inside the walls or coping (concrete) shall not be classified as impervious.
